

ACL Reconstruction?

The MSU Center for Orthopedic Research is studying motor control in individuals **with and without anterior cruciate ligament reconstruction.**

Who can participate?

- » Those **WITH anterior cruciate ligament reconstruction** in the last 5 years resulting from a non-contact injury, returned to full activity, and do not have low back pain
- » Those **WITHOUT anterior cruciate ligament reconstruction** and are physically active, and do not have low back pain
- » All participants must be between the ages of **18 and 45**

What is involved with participating?

- » **Perform** 1-2 testing sessions lasting no more than 4 hours total
Testing sessions involve assessment of motor control and balance tasks of the knee, hip and trunk.
- » **Complete** questionnaires
- » **Receive** up to \$40 compensation
