ACL Reconstruction?

The MSU Center for Orthopedic Research is studying motor control in individuals with and without anterior cruciate ligament reconstruction.

Who can participate?

- » Those **WITH** anterior cruciate ligament reconstruction in the last 5 years resulting from a non-contact injury, returned to full activity, and do not have low back pain
- » Those **WITHOUT** anterior cruciate ligament reconstruction and are physically active, and do not have low back pain
- » All participants must be between the ages of 18 and 45

What is involved with participating?

- **» Perform** 1-2 testing sessions lasting no more than 4 hours total Testing sessions involve assessment of motor control and balance tasks of the knee, hip and trunk.

- » Receive up to \$40 compensation
